- Discussion is centering around potential young adult ministry hire shared among the five Neenah-Menasha parishes, as well as small groups within the parish and among parishioners.
- V. Building and Grounds Committee Update Mike V.
 - One by One campaign construction beginning.
 - St. Gabriel campus space study will be done on December 10, 2021.
 - University of Wisconsin—Oshkosh completing study pro bono/part of graduate project.
 - Study includes entire campus and will include representatives from parish, school, etc.
