#### Financials (Anne)

- Anne shared the financial report summary of budget, actuals and budget for next year
  - o Actual \$770 loss
  - Plan to send it out along with a letter
    - Father to mention something at Mass prior to the letter going out
    - Father to mention that we are doing a parish directory
    - Suggestion to mention the raffle
  - o Discussion on the annual meeting
    - When 10/8 with Pete; 10/15 with Mike. Update after talking to Pete- he could do it October 22 or 29<sup>th</sup>. Date to be confirmed.
- Reviewed letter to Father
  - Anne mentioned the envelope income is ahead of last year, but behind per budget
    - Included a 4% increase to help balance out the budget
- Follow ups from our last meeting
  - We had ~\$13K left in the checking account. Anne to explain what the starting balances were for the last 3 years
    - Anne to send out cash flow analysis to the entire council
- Did have a discussion on investments versus endowments.
  - Discussion on using one of them for our subsidy to the Catholic schools. A second fund will be used for adult education/RE
    - Was able to balance the budget by including some of the income from the investment funds
- Discussion on Positive Pay
  - The church sends a file of issued checks to the bank. The bank then responds on a daily basis with checks presented for payment. These checks are not paid until they
