Minutes

- Dave R motion to approve. Joe V seconded APPROVED

Financials (Anne)

- Roughly \$8,608 ahead of budgeted parish support for envelopes/loose offertory
- Personnel expense roughly \$3,756 under budget
- Shared expenses \$14,800 under budget (likely from mild temp)
- SCRIP \$2,800 below budget but carrying higher inventory of roughly the same amount

Old Business

- Looking for sexton and new member to cemetery board to help sexton
- Sexton position has had applicants and interviews
- Meeting coming up Tuesday February 6th for cemetery board
- Deacon Tom was communicating with the berm neighbor and there has been dialogue

New Business

- QR codes for giving in the bulletin, will not have stickers in pews due to concern for potential for fraud, will request an announcement before Mass and in Friday email to explain use
- Julie be cautious with posted QR codes as they can be manipulated
- Joe some use of out of visitor envelopes but QR codes for younger generations

B&G Update (Mike)

- 6 focus areas and working with the school
- Met with Dan McKenna, there are many other priorities but not opposed to spending if a plan is in place

- Security Luebke provides certain membrane with 20 year warranty, but many have been fine for 30-35 years. Normal rubber roof = 20 years. Initial cost is somewhat cheaper than rubber as well
- Misc changing of lights and other small updates
- Seems to be less melting snow/drainage issues in west parking lot with the new berm and snow piles being pushed further south.
- Organ pipes are gone, potentially building a loft in that area for additional storage
 - Anne concerned due to insurance safety first, a staircase will be built for access
 - Potential Christmas decoration storage

- Stations look great, thoughts on lighting? Lighting consultant looking at it
- Pete suggested battery operated lights with remote controls?
- Positive comments on before and after updates
- Pete suggested updating sacristy? What is the priority? Pews?

- Pews are in somewhat rough shape, solid oak pews, aim to refinish? Laser sanding?
- Sanctuary side walls (cheese-grater) ideas being bounced around
- A dozen or so old extra pews from when church was rearranged keep a few until after refinishing
